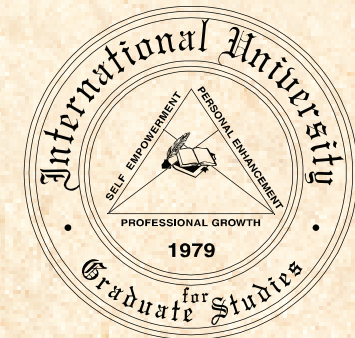

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## ACCREDITATION AND AFFILIATIONS

IUGS was founded in 1979 and is incorporated in the Commonwealth of Dominica, an independent country that is a member of the British Commonwealth of Nations. The University operates under a permit from the Ministry of Education and Human Resource Development of the Commonwealth of Dominica. IUGS is accredited by the National Accreditation Board of the Commonwealth of Dominica.

Accreditation from a sovereign country is the highest form of accreditation.

In addition, the University has had:

- Approval for tuition reimbursement and payment from major U.S. hospitals, unions, government agencies and private institutions;
- Co-sponsored continuing-education programs with U.S. and International certification, licensing agencies and organizations;
